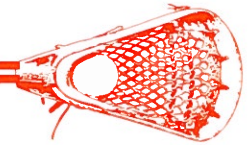

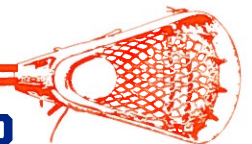


## **DON ROSS**

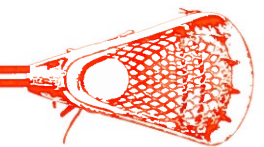

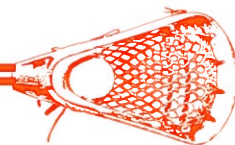


## **ANDREW GODFREY**

Andrew Godfrey was one of the finest lacrosse players to play at Manhasset High School. Andrew was a very smooth midfielder who did everything from scoring goals to being our key face off man for two years. In addition, he was deadly on extra man and probably would have been our best man down player if we could have used him. Other coaches recognized his talent, as he became one of the very few players to be a high school All-American for two years.

One of the most recruited players in the nation went to Johns Hopkins where he starred as one of their key midfielders for three years. Again, he was recognized as an All-American his junior and senior years.

## **BRIAN BYRNES**

Brian Byrnes enjoyed an outstanding career in lacrosse and hockey. At St. Mary's High School he was a 4 year starter in lacrosse and was selected to the All Catholic team his sophomore, junior and senior years. He was selected as the outstanding player in the league his senior year and an All-American.

At the University of New Hampshire he started all four years and was a first team ECAC selection all four years He also earned All New England honors his sophomore, junior and senior years and captained the team his junior and senior years. He was a North South selection his senior year and graduated as the third all time scorer and all time leader in assists.

As a hockey player Brian started all four years at the University of New Hampshire and signed as a free agent with the Boston Bruins.

## **LAUREN FORNASAR BARRETT**

Lauren Fornasar Barrett was one of the most outstanding multisport athletes to attend Manhasset High School. As a tennis player she achieved All-American status as she helped win a New York State Championship in doubles in the fall of 1983.

In lacrosse, Lauren was a three-year starter as a defensive player on some of Manhasset's most outstanding teams. She would often be called on to play the other teams' most talented offensive layer. She was a key to Manhasset's first New York State championship team. She achieved numerous personal awards including All Conference, All County and being named defensive player of the year at Manhasset in 1986.

Lauren received a scholarship to the University of Virginia but was injured and was not able to finish her collegiate playing career.

## **DOUGH FUCHS**

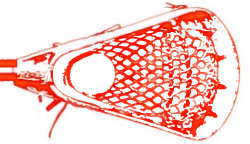
Doug Fuchs played midfield for Manhasset High School, lettering in 1965, 1966 and 1967. Doug was a tremendous two-way player especially excelling at picking up ground balls and playing excellent defense. His leadership qualities were recognized by his teammates as he was elected co-captain of the legendary undefeated 1967 team, a team with only fifteen players on it. Doug is the eighth member of the '67 team to be inducted into this Hall of Fame. Doug was voted All-Division his senior year.

He continued his lacrosse career at Johns Hopkins University where he was a member of two national championship teams. He was again recognized for his leadership qualities by being elected the captain of his freshmen team and captain of the varsity his senior season.

Dr. Doug Fuchs is currently on the faculty of Vanderbilt University where he is a nationally known scholar in education. Congratulations.

## J. B. MEYER

J.B. Meyer had an exceptional career as a goaltender. At Manhasset J.B. was the captain of the team his senior year and elected to the All Division Team and the All County Team.

J.B. then went on to the University of Virginia where he had an outstanding collegiate career. He was rookie of the year in 1981. In 1983 J.B. became the first undergraduate in four decades at the University of Virginia to be elected captain. He also made the All ACC first team. He was elected captain again his senior year and added All-American to his honors of All ACC first team and runner up to the ACC player of the year. He was chosen to play for the South team on the North South game.

J.B. continues to give back to the game by working with the PAL program.

## CHERI DICERBO

Cheri DiCerbo is part of the tradition of very talented athletes who achieved outstanding success in a variety of sports. Cheri played basketball and helped to start the first girl's soccer team here at Manhasset. She also captained one of the 1986 Sports Nights' teams.

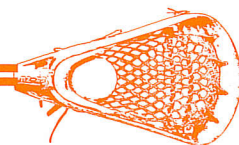

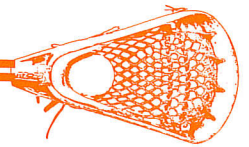
